

## **Statutes of the Tallinn University Internationalisation Fund**

Tallinn University Senate Regulation No. 5 of 16 April 2018

This regulation is adopted pursuant to § 9 (35) of the Statutes of Tallinn University and § 16 (7) of the Tallinn University Regulations of Economic Activity and on the proposal of 10 April 2018 by the Development and Economic Affairs Committee of the Senate.

### **I General Provisions**

1. The purpose of Tallinn University (hereinafter the “University”) Internationalisation Fund (hereinafter the “Fund”) is to promote activities related to the internationalisation of the University and to develop international cooperation.

2. The Fund is intended, in particular, to finance the following lines of action:

2.1 establishing and maintaining cooperation with strategic international partner universities;

2.2 the University’s participation in and cooperation with international academic networks (except for the payment of membership fees);

2.3 student exchanges with bilateral partners;

2.4 University staff speaking at high-level international conferences and events;

2.5 the development of management practices at the University and its units, as well as the establishment of the University’s identity.

3. The Fund is formed of contributions from the budget of the University and revenue earmarked for a specific purpose.

4. The Fund is managed and its priorities for action for each financial year are approved by the Rector, or a Vice-Rector designated by the Rector, who will decide on the use of the Fund’s resources in 50 % of cases independently, and in 50 % of cases through a University-wide thematic call for applications.

5. The Fund manager has the right to decide not to use the Fund’s instruments if the applications submitted in a call for applications do not correspond to the Fund’s objectives and the University's Development Plan.

### **II Implementing Provision**

TU Senate Regulation No. 11 on the Statutes of the Development and Cooperation Fund dated 21 November 2011 shall be repealed.
